MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Algebra 1 or post high school equivalency with a passing grade
- Must be at least 18 years of age (*proof required*)
- High School Diploma or GED

Employers may require a you to have a valid driver's license and submit to a pre-employment substance abuse test.

*Veterans who have GI Benefits may use them in this program
Applicants who are veterans and have proof of service will receive additional points towards application score.*

All applications are reviewed and scored based on the applicant's documentation. The applicants who meet the minimum qualifications and complete the interview will be scored and ranked. Based on the score– the applicants are then placed in ranked order to the **Pool of Eligibles**. All supporting documents must be submitted by the closing date of announcement.
